Take Exit 29 to Route 65 (Sharpsburg Pike). Travel south on Route 65 for approximately 7 miles. Keedysville Road will be on your left. Travel on Keedysville Road for approximately 1 mile and the sign to WMREC will be on the left.

From Boonsboro:

Take Route 34 West at the stoplight in Boonsboro. Travel for 3.5 miles. Turn right onto Keedysville Road and travel 2.4 miles. The WMREC entrance will be on the right, just past University Road.
